**CITY TO CLAYTON BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT**

Here are some tips to help you when travelling to Clayton Campus on public transport:

- ▶ Go to Flinders Street Station platform 6 or 7
- ▶ Catch a train on the Pakenham/Cranbourne line
- ▶ Get off at Huntingdale Station
- ▶ Catch the 601 bus that will take you directly to Monash University bus loop.
- ▶ 49 Rainforest Walk is 2 minutes walking distance from the bus loop.
