From day one at Monash College, we focus on teaching you the skills you need to succeed at university and beyond, providing you with a guaranteed entry into Monash University[^].

Which pathway is right for you?

FOUNDATION YEAR

A pre-university program that prepares you for first year at Monash University. Foundation Year offers a broad range of subjects and is accepted by all 10 Monash University faculties.

Ideal for those still deciding on their career path or for those who do not have a high school qualification that is eligible for direct entry.

DIPLOMA

Specialise from day one with a Monash College Diploma – you'll be studying subjects related to your Monash University undergraduate degree. The Diploma program is offered in two parts.

By successfully completing Diploma Part 2, you'll be able to fast-track into the second year of your selected undergraduate degree at Monash University.

Ideal for those who know what direction they want to head in or for those who missed out on the direct-entry score into Monash University.

ENGLISH

Monash English ensures all English language students will complete their language program ready to study or work with confidence and see themselves as citizens of a larger community.

Foundation Year

Offered in the heart of Melbourne or at one of our international partners, our Foundation Year program offers guaranteed entry into first year at Monash University upon successful completion and meeting all the entry requirements.

We offer 13 subjects as part of Foundation Year.

Each subject has a set of learning objectives that are aligned with the requirements for Monash University. You'll learn the core academic skills required to prepare you for your successful study at Monash University. Our curriculum and blended learning combines essential theory and practical knowledge with the four skills critical to your future studies and your career: critical thinking; problem solving; communication and collaboration; and core academic skills.

DID YOU KNOW?

The Foundation Year program will lead you into all 10 faculties at Monash University. It is also the only Monash pathway into degrees in Medicine, Nursing, Health Sciences, Pharmacy and Law.

Diploma

Undertaking a Diploma is the quickest path to second year at Monash University.

The Diploma program is offered in two parts, and where you start depends on your academic results.

In part 2 of your Diploma, you'll study the same subjects as first-year university students.

Our Diploma classes are smaller than those at university. This means you'll receive extra help, support and more individual attention from your teachers to help you learn and grow.

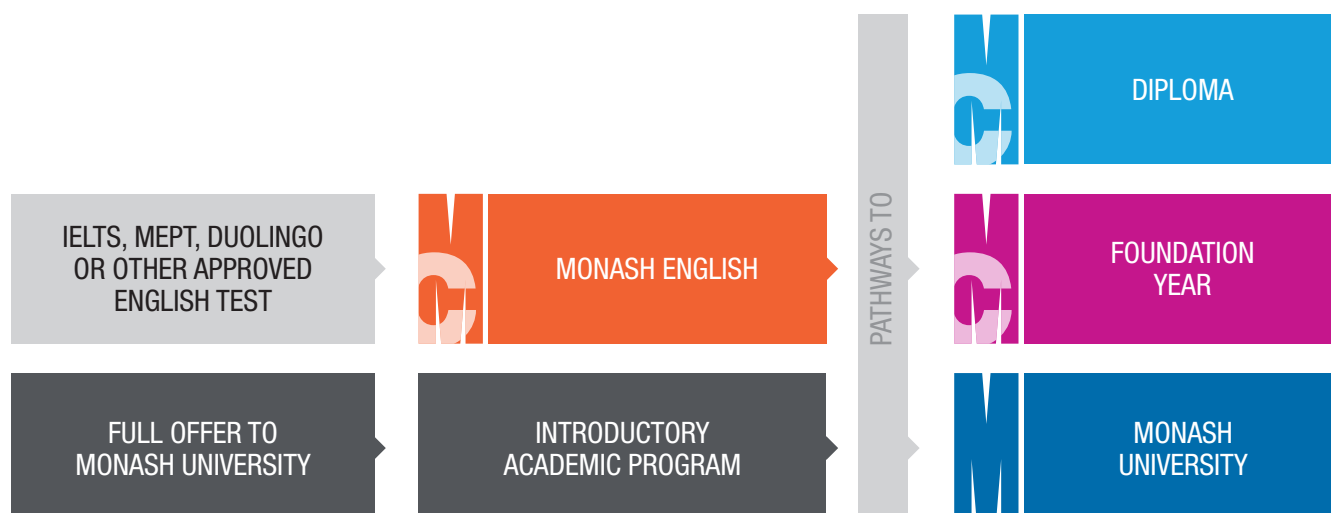
English
