WHAT TO CONSIDER?

Choosing to study in a different country is a big decision. There's lots to prepare for, from financial planning to accommodation, their visa, insurance, how to stay connected and preparing your child to live independently.

Here are a few tips to get you started:

FINANCIAL PLANNING

Before your child arrives in Melbourne, it's a good idea to prepare a budget.

Your child may need spending money for things like medication or other personal items, such as clothes, groceries, utilities, public transport and entertainment.

COST-OF-LIVING

Prices will vary depending on where your child lives. As a rough guide, we recommend between \$35,000 and \$50,000 per year for cost-of-living expenses, depending on type of accomodation and lifestyle choices.

Calculate your estimated costs at www.studyaustralia.gov.au.

Depending on your child's chosen degree, there may be additional costs for class materials and other course requirements. Make sure you check this before they commence their studies.

HEALTH INSURANCE

All student visa holders must have Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC), which provides medical and hospital insurance while studying in Australia. Your child must obtain this before they arrive in Australia. For further details, visit www.monash.edu/fees/oshc

ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS

We have a range of Monash College-approved accommodation providers that are close to campus. Our approved accommodation providers, such as Scape, Journal Student Living or Iglu, offer secure, apartment-style living with lots of student facilities. All rooms are fully furnished and staff are available 24 hours a day to provide support. This is a great option for students living away from home for the first time.

If your child is over 18 and comfortable living on your own, you can also rent your own place or share with friends.

It's important to choose the accommodation option that best suits your child's living and learning preferences. Apply for the accommodation early to secure your child's preferred option. For more information visit www.monashcollege.edu.au/accommodation

SAFETY

We know that moving to a new country can be exciting and challenging at the same time for child. Take comfort knowing your child will be living in a safe city, with Melbourne ranked as one of the top 10 cities in the world by the Safe Cities Index.

STAYING CONNECTED

HOW TO STAY IN TOUCH

It's important to plan when and how you will communicate while your child is in Melbourne. Have them contact you upon arriving so you know they reached their destination safely. Set up a schedule to keep in touch, arranging a time to talk in advance. Consider apps for communicating long distances, such as WhatsApp, Zoom or Facebook Messenger.

PREPARING YOUR CHILD FOR RESPONSIBILITIES

This is likely to be the first time your child is living away from home. They'll need to understand how to manage their own finances, organise their time, clean and make their own meals. Think about how you can prepare them for this new stage in life. Our team is also here to answer any questions your child may have to help them in get settled.

PLANNING A VISIT

If you plan to visit, we recommend waiting a few months into their study abroad before you go. It's important to give your child time to immerse themselves and create their own routines before you arrive.

FOR UNDER 18 STUDENTS

At Monash College, we specialise in helping younger students settle into life in Melbourne. We understand that students under 18 need the extra care and support.

CHOOSING A GUARDIAN

If your child is under 18, they must have a guardian while they live in Melbourne. This can be a parent, relative or a Monash College guardian.

Our guardians will help your child with:

- organising orientation
- · opening a bank account
- · accommodation advice
- arranging medical appointments
- support during emergencies
- reporting to you as parents.

Accommodation for students under 18 must also be approved before your child applies for a student visa.
