Living in Melbourne will be a big part of your student experience. The best accommodation option for you will depend on your age, your campus and the type of experience you want.

Age

If you are under 18 years of age when you first arrive, you will need to stay in accommodation approved for under age students. Many of our recommended accommodation providers are suited to younger students and offer more support and security.

If you are over 18, you can stay at whichever provider suits your campus and the experience you would like.

Campus

If you are studying the Monash University Foundation Year or Monash English you will be based at our Melbourne City campus at 222 Bourke Street. We recommend you choose somewhere close to the campus.

If you are studying a diploma, undergraduate or postgraduate course or the Monash English Bridging program, you will be based at either Clayton or Caulfield. There are many options available to you.

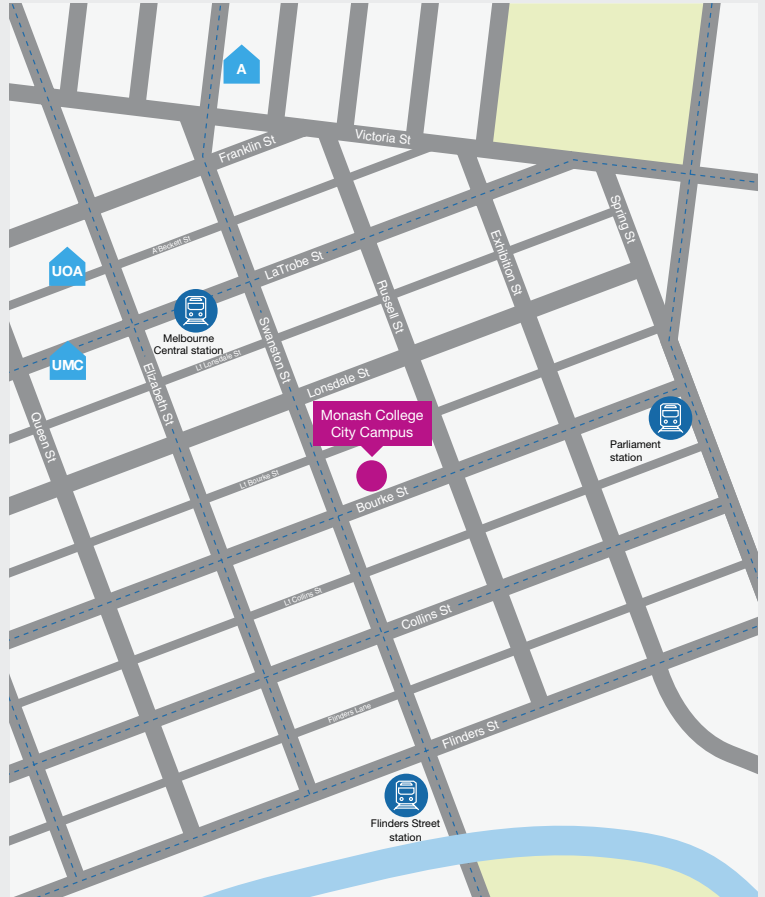

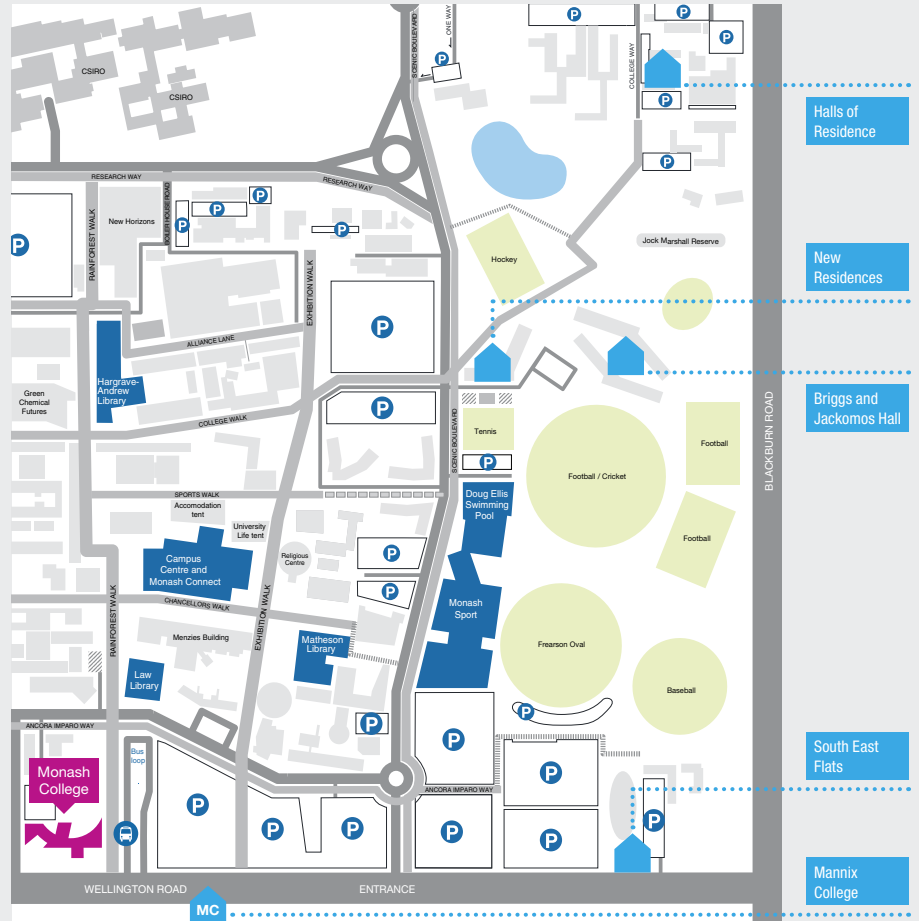
