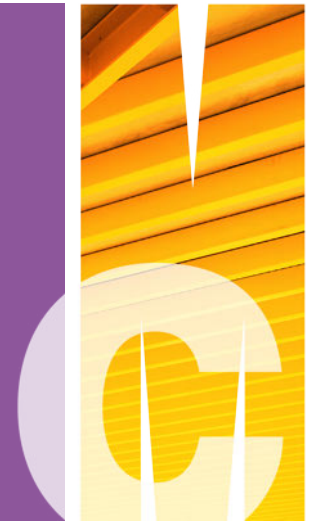


BECOME AN AUTHORISED MEPT INVIGILATOR



Monash English Placement Test (MEPT) is a free English language placement tool available for authorised Monash agents to administer when Monash applicants cannot provide evidence of their English proficiency through an IELTS or other accepted international English tests.

MEPT is designed to assess applicants' current English ability in order to match them to the most appropriate Monash English course. The free, one-hour test can be taken at any Monash-approved agent's office. Based on the test results, students may receive a packaged offer for Monash English and their destination course. MEPT only tests reading and writing skills, not speaking or listening.

It is important to note that after completing Monash English, students wishing to enter Monash College diplomas and Monash University undergraduate and postgraduate degrees must meet the English prerequisites and achieve the required IELTS (or equivalent) score.

APPLYING

To ensure accountability and proper MEPT invigilation, only authorised Agents can use the Monash English Placement Test. Agencies may have up to two approved MEPT invigilators per office.

Apply to become an authorised MEPT invigilator:
